The elements of the Unite Club Program include:

THE UNITE CLUB CURRICULUM

Modules cover such soft skills and topics as personal branding and emotional intelligence, leadership, time management, networking, social media, communication and listening skills, feedback vs. criticism, coping with stress and anxiety, environmental stewardship, collaboration and teamwork, and more.

THE UNITE PASSION PROJECT

A series of online videos that exposes students to a wide array of career options, activities, and perspectives by sharing the stories from people from around the world who have found their passions.

OPPORTUNITIES TO ENGAGE

In activities such as debates, spelling bees, talent shows, public speaking events, art activities, tree-planting campaigns, community service outreach, and more.

Unite provides each partner school club (as needed and as possible) with a laptop, projector, smartphone, and modem along with notebooks, pens, and Unite T-shirts. Each club must assign a faculty leader as well as student club leaders who are responsible for communicating and coordinating with Unite leadership in Tanzania and the United States to work collaboratively to make the clubs as impactful and successful as possible.
